Explanatory Notes on the Fauna List

Status = Conservation Status as listed under the Qld Nature Conservation Act 1992, and is current at the date of this version of the fauna list. Introduced and translocated species have also been indicated in this column for convenience.

Abundance = an estimation of the local abundance of this species with the Gold Coast City Council area, which for the purpose of this fauna list includes all areas of land and water within the City boundary and coastal waters to ca. 400m beyond the low water mark (ie approximate limit of shark netting program).

Terms used for local abundance are defined as follows

Common = likely to be encountered without much difficulty in suitable habitat.

Uncommon = species that are likely to be encountered irregularly eg only after several visits to an area

Rare = rarely encountered species. May include species that are locally common but only within a restricted area.

Vagrant = Non-resident species encountered less than five times within the past ten years

Rare Visitor = Rarely encountered oceanic species which may be common to rare in offshore waters

A number of pelagic seabirds not yet recorded within the City boundary are known to be common to vagrant species in offshore waters from established records (particularly SOSSA field trips off Southport). These include:

Flesh-footed Shearwater, Wilson's Storm-Petrel (common in offshore waters);

Hutton's Shearwater, Black-bellied Storm-Petrel, Brown Booby, Artic Jaeger (uncommon but regularly sited offshore);

Tahiti Petrel, Shy Albatross, Indian Yellow-nosed Albatross, White-bellied Storm-Petrel, Long-tailed Jaeger,

Bridled Tern, Black Noddy (rare offshore);

Mottled Petrel, Soft-plumaged Petrel, Black Petrel, Broad-billed Prion, White-capped Albatross, Buller's Albatross,

Masked Booby and South Polar Skua (offshore vagrants)

This fauna list provides a summary of confirmed fauna species records for the Gold Coast City area, based on existing knowledge at the time of this version of the list. Only fish species known to spend part or all of their lifecycle within freshwater habitats are included in this version of the list.
